

Belonging -> Driving Team Engagement




Facilitation of Team Meetings



- Have a clear agenda and a HARD stop
- Lead from the back (empower your team)
- Arrive early to be the first to welcome
- Ice breaker + start with recognizing positives
- Use name when asking a question (Mary, what..)
- Actively promote peers to recognize peers



Belonging → Driving Team Engagement




Facilitation of Team Meetings

- Interactivity every 5 minutes
- Use breakout rooms
- Turn on closed captioning,
- Send documents and collect input in advance
- Create FAQ (speaking points) for Leaders



Belonging → Driving Team Engagement




Team building

- Use technology to create virtual break rooms, "Happy Hour" events, etc. by leaving an ongoing videoconferencing session open
- Virtual prizes Amazon gift ecards emailed to staff
- "Virtual pizza party" i.e. real pizza delivered to each attendee's home



Belonging -> Driving Team Engagement




Virtual Blended Training

- Virtual training method and strategy should match complexity of content
- Test often for knowledge retention and understanding
- Alternate eLearning & live facilitator led virtual training
- Multi-media for different learning styles: eLearning, chat, phone, recorded calls/video, live videoconferencing & independent practice



Belonging → Driving Team Engagement



Virtual Blended Training cont'd

Teach back retention of knowledge through screen sharing

Use the same facilitation techniques as in the earlier slides

Use Kahoot.com app for simple quizzes and contests



How do I know I'm on the right path?



Ask for feedback more often



Create an engagement plan
